
Dear Secretary Johnson:

I write concerning a missed statutory reporting deadline from Public Law 114-150, the Department of Homeland Security Headquarters Consolidation Accountability Act of 2015, which became law on April 29, 2016. The law specifies that “[n]ot later than 120 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary, in coordination with the Administrator, shall submit to the appropriate committees of Congress information on the implementation of the enhanced plan for the Department headquarters consolidation project within the National Capital Region.”¹

This deadline has passed and the Committee has not received the required report, received any notification from the Department that the deadline would be missed, or received any indication when it could expect to receive the report.

I ask that DHS provide Committee staff a briefing as soon as possible, but no later than September 12, 2016 to inform the Committee of this issue. Thank you for your prompt response. If you have any questions, please ask your staff to contact David Luckey with the majority staff at (202) 224-4585.
