A BILL

To increase access to agency guidance documents.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Guidance Out Of
- 5 Darkness Act" or the "GOOD Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 7 In this Act:
- 8 (1) AGENCY.—The term "agency" has the
- 9 meaning given that term in section 551 of title 5,
- 10 United States Code.

1	(2) Director.—The term "Director" means
2	the Director of the Office of Management and Budg-
3	et.
4	(3) Guidance document.—The term "guid-
5	ance document''—
6	(A) means an agency statement of general
7	applicability (other than a rule that has the
8	force and effect of law promulgated in accord-
9	ance with the notice and comment procedures
10	under section 553 of title 5, United States
11	Code) that—
12	(i) does not have the force and effect
13	of law; and
14	(ii) sets forth—
15	(I) an agency decision or a policy
16	on a statutory, regulatory, or tech-
17	nical issue; or
18	(II) an interpretation of a statu-
19	tory or regulatory issue; and
20	(B) may include—
21	(i) a memorandum;
22	(ii) a notice;
23	(iii) a bulletin;
24	(iv) a directive;
25	(v) a news release;

1	(vi) a letter;
2	(vii) a blog post;

12	SEC. 3. PUBLICATION OF GUIDANCE DOCUMENTS ON THE
13	INTERNET.
14	(a) In General.—On the date on which an agency
15	issues a guidance document, the agency shall publish the
16	guidance document in accordance with the requirements
17	under subsection (c).
18	(b) Previously Issued Guidance Documents.—
19	Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of
20	this Act, each agency shall publish, in accordance with the
21	requirements under subsection (c), any guidance docu-
22	ment issued by that agency that is in effect on that date.
23	(c) SINGLE LOCATION.—
24	(1) In general.—All guidance documents pub-
25	lished under subsections (a) and (b) by an agency

1	shall be published in a single location on an internet
2	website designated by the Director under paragraph
3	(4).
4	(2) AGENCY INTERNET WEBSITES.—Each agen-
5	cy shall, for guidance documents published by the
6	agency under subsections (a) and (b), publish a
7	hyperlink on the internet website of the agency that
8	provides access to the guidance documents at the lo-
9	cation described in paragraph (1).
10	(3) Organization.—
11	(A) In General.—The guidance docu-
12	ments described in paragraph (1) shall be—
13	(i) categorized as guidance docu-
14	ments; and
15	(ii) further divided into subcategories
16	as appropriate.
17	(B) AGENCY INTERNET WEBSITES.—The
18	hyperlinks described in paragraph (2) shall be
19	prominently displayed on the internet website of
20	the agency.
21	(4) Designation.—Not later than 90 days
22	after the date of enactment of this Act, the Director
23	shall designate an internet website on which guid-
24	ance documents shall be published under subsections
25	(a) and (b).

1	(d) RESCINDED GUIDANCE DOCUMENTS.—On the
2	date on which a guidance document issued by an agency
3	is rescinded, or, in the case of a guidance document that
4	is rescinded pursuant to a court order, not later than the
5	date on which the order is entered, the agency shall, at
6	the location described in subsection (c)(1)—
7	(1) maintain the rescinded guidance document
8	and
9	(2) indicate—
10	(A) that the guidance document is re-
11	scinded;
12	(B) if the guidance document was re-
13	scinded pursuant to a court order, the case
14	number of the case in which the order was en-
15	tered; and
16	(C) the date on which the guidance docu-
17	ment was rescinded.
