

Ending Democrats' Defunding of Border Security and Law Enforcement

Section 1: Paying Customs and Border Protection (CBP)

Personnel

Provides \$19.1 billion to hire, train, pay, and equip Customs and Border Protection personnel through Fiscal Year 2029. This includes Border Patrol Agents, Office of Field Operations officers, Air and Marine agents, rehired annuitants, and Customs and Border Protection headquarters and field support personnel.

Section 2: Paying Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE)

Personnel

Provides \$7.5 billion to hire, train, pay, and equip Homeland Security Investigations personnel through Fiscal Year 2029 to support domestic law enforcement investigations.

Section 3: Border Security, Technology, and Screening

Provides \$3.5 billion for improvements to border security through Fiscal Year 2029, including air and marine operations and efforts to combat drug trafficking, as well as screening persons entering or exiting the country.

Section 4: Additional Homeland Security Funding

Provides \$2.5 billion through Fiscal Year 2029 to the Department of Homeland Security to ensure adequate funding for border security across the board.
