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**A BILL**

To amend the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 to clarify a provision relating to certain contents of registrations under that Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Disclosing Foreign In-  
5 fluence in Lobbying Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF CONTENTS OF REGISTRATION.**

7 Section 4(b) of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995  
8 (2 U.S.C. 1603(b)) is amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (6), by striking “and” at the  
2           end; and

3           (2) in paragraph (7), by striking “the offense.”  
4           and inserting the following: “the offense; and

5           “(8) notwithstanding paragraph (4), the name  
6           and address of each government of a foreign country  
7           (including any agency or subdivision of a foreign  
8           government, such as a regional or municipal unit of  
9           government) and foreign political party, other than  
10          the client, that participates in the direction, plan-  
11          ning, supervision, or control of any lobbying activi-  
12          ties of the registrant.”.
