

My name is Nick Shirley. I am a 100% independent journalist who works each day for “We the People,” with a mission to show the world the reality of things as they really are. Through my efforts, I have exposed billions of dollars of fraud and helped America save hundreds of billions of dollars for years to come.

When we talk about fraud, we are talking about money stolen from hardworking, law-abiding, taxpaying citizens. This issue has nothing to do with political parties, because no dollar says Republican or Democrat on it. When a fraudster commits fraud, he or she steals from all of us. The worst part is that fraud affects the most vulnerable and needy, as they rely the most on government services.

Last December, I published a 43-minute video exposing widespread fraud in Minnesota. The fraud was so obvious that the infamous “learning center” was born. That video has become the most consequential in American history by the amount of legislation it created. Since posting it, over 30 bills have been introduced in Congress regarding fraud, a new fraud task force has been created, and the Treasury is working on systems to stop fraud at unprecedented levels. I ignited a war on fraud across the country.

People wonder how fraud became so rampant in the United States. It is because no one ever looked before. When Elon Musk offered to help by creating DOGE, people burned his factories, bombed his cars, and politicians celebrated his company’s stock going down. Elon was right when he said, “The fraudsters always complain the loudest.”

By exposing the fraud, I also exposed the politicians and media who worked for years to cover it up. Governor Tim Walz labeled my work as “white supremacy” and called me a “far-right... delusional conspiracy theorist.” Meanwhile, he dropped out of reelection and ended his political career. Now the highest government-funded daycare in Minnesota has pleaded guilty to daycare fraud, and the largest autism fraud bust in American history has been exposed. Where is Tim Walz and the mainstream media now?

After Minnesota, I exposed widespread daycare and hospice fraud in California, where an impossible one-third of Americans on hospice care were set to die in LA. The next day, the Governor posted an AI-generated image mocking me to discredit my work. Only days later, he and his Attorney General tried to take credit for exposing the fraud. Now the Attorney General’s wife has created a bill that would make it criminal to expose fraud. The “Stop Nick Shirley Act” (AB 2624) will help fraudsters cover up their crimes.

California’s Medicaid program has doubled from \$108 billion to \$222 billion while enrollment rose by less than 1%. The system is filled with fraudsters. California is functionally bankrupt.

In NYC, government-funded adult daycares pay for elderly Koreans and Chinese to play ping pong and do tai chi. An impossible number of patients are registered, and those patients receive kickbacks for attending and signing up friends. Over \$2 billion has gone to these fraudsters at taxpayers’ expense.

I have also exposed potential voter fraud in California where the voter rolls, allow for 126 year olds to be registered, they are not actually 126 years old but the voter rolls say so. By providing an ID when you vote would easily flag and fix this error. In California a dog was able to vote in 2 elections and was only caught when the owner turned herself in to prove a point. It's been proven through the work of others that the homeless were being paid to vote in California. How can we allow this?

I am one person doing the work of many people. If the government and the media is not going to do their job to help America it's the responsibility of strong men and women to do it. I am doing it, despite the threats and burdens that come, it must be done. I am doing it with the help everyday Americans doing the work that many paid government officials and media teams should be doing and they have failed all of us. If we as Americans do not stand up to protect our country, we will lose our country.

Fraud is so rampant in the United States that I could go to all 50 states and uncover millions of tax dollars being defrauded, wasted and abused. It is my wish while sitting in front of Congress today that you take action and help Americans by taking massive action to protect our tax dollars and end the fraud and to always put Americans first.
