- Lead Agent : On August 14, 2024, the former Acting Director of the Secret Service placed Lead Agent in an unofficial restricted duty status. She remained in this status until May 1, 2025.
- SAIC Pittsburgh : On August 14, 2024, the former Acting Director of the Secret Service placed Pittsburgh in an unofficial restricted duty status. He remained in this status until he received a Management Directed Reassignment (MDR) to a non-operational assignment in another office on December 29, 2024. See Bates 025051-025053.
- Site Counterpart : On August 14, 2024, the former Acting Director of the Secret Service placed Site Counterpart in an unofficial restricted duty status. She remained in this status until May 1, 2025
- ATSAIC Pittsburgh : On August 14, 2024, the former Acting Director of the Se ret Service placed ATSAIC Pittsburgh in an unofficial restricted duty status. He remained in this status until May 1, 2025.
- C/S Team Lead : On December 20, 2024, the former Acting Director of the Secret Service placed
 in an unofficial restricted duty status. He currently remains in this status.
- Site Agent : On August 16, 2024, the former Acting Director of the Secret Service placed Site Agent in an unofficial restricted duty status. During the stimeframe, Site Agent received a MDR from a protective office to an investigative office on December 15, 2024. Although she was reassigned, she remained in the restricted duty status until April 4, 2025. See Bates 025059-025060.
- Intel Advance Lead : On Augu t 14, 2024, the former Acting Director of the Secret Service placed Intel Advance Lead in an unofficial restrict d duty status. He remained in that status until he resigned from the agency on September 13, 2024.
- Hercules 1 C/S : Please note that on July 14, 2024, Sergeant Technician Hercules 1 C/S was put on administrative leave pursuant to RES 07(05), which states hat immediately following a shooting or deadly force incident, the affected employee will immediately be placed on administrative leave, pending the local and/or federal law enforcement investigation. F flowing administrative leave, Hercules 1 C/S was placed in a desk duty status on July 25, 2024. He returned on November 26, 2024, upon clearance by the agency's Shooting or Deadly Incident Review Committee (SIR C). See Bates 025054-025058.
- SAIC Buffalo : After the Mission Assurance Inquiry review was completed, as part of the determination of which employees might face discipline, SAIC Buffalo was found not to be in violation of Secret Service policy. SAIC Buffalo retired on June 28, 2025.
