We are writing to invite you to testify before the Subcommittee on Contracting Oversight at a hearing entitled, "Interagency Contracts (Part II): Management and Oversight." The hearing will be held on Wednesday, June 30, 2010 at 2:30 P.M. in Room SD-342 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building. This hearing will be the Subcommittee's second hearing on interagency contracting.

The purpose of the hearing is to examine the management and oversight of interagency contracts. The hearing will review the reasons behind the rapid proliferation of interagency contracting vehicles in recent years. The hearing will also explore whether agencies are creating and using these vehicles responsibly. In addition, the hearing will assess the need for increased transparency, oversight, and other potential reforms.

Your testimony should address the recent Government Accountability Office report entitled, Contracting Strategies: Data and Oversight Problems Hamper Opportunities to Leverage Value of Interagency and Enterprisewide Contracts. You should also discuss the potential benefits and shortcomings of interagency contracting for the federal government, taxpayers, and small and large businesses. In addition, you should be prepared to discuss GAO's recommendations regarding how the federal government can ensure that interagency contracting is as competitive, efficient, and transparent as possible.

The Subcommittee requests that you summarize your testimony in 5 minutes, although a longer written statement may be submitted for the official record. This will allow adequate time for you to engage in questions and answers with members of the Subcommittee. Subcommittee rules require that your testimony be submitted by no later than 2:30 P.M. on Monday, June 28, 2010.
