On the call, Subcommittee staff and FPS staff discussed the possibility of instituting basic ethics and procurement training for FPS leadership. Given the ethical lapses that apparently occurred in the case of Mr. , and the potential for similar lapses going forward, I believe that such training would be useful for FPS, and I welcome the interest and willingness of FPS officials to develop this program.

I look forward to hearing from you regarding FPS' progress in developing this training. I hope that it will serve as a model for the rest of the Department of Homeland Security and the federal government.
