We ask you to testify at a hearing entitled "Medicaid Fraud and Overpayments: Problems and Solutions" before the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs on Wednesday, June 20, 2018, at 10 a.m. in SD-342 in the Dirksen Senate Office Building.

The purpose of this hearing is to examine the Medicaid program's vulnerability to fraud and overpayments. We ask that your testimony discuss the efforts of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to fight Medicaid fraud and overpayments and how CMS safeguards taxpayer dollars in the Medicaid program.

The Committee has sought your testimony on this subject matter since April 20; however, you have declined repeatedly to confirm that you will testify. Accordingly, please confirm that you will testify at this hearing as soon as possible but no later than 5 p.m. on May 21, 2018. If the Committee does not receive this confirmation, we may be forced to seek alternative means to compel your testimony.

The committee requests that you summarize your testimony in <u>5 minutes or less</u>, although a longer written statement may be submitted for the official record. This will allow adequate time for you to engage in questions and answers with members of the committee. The Committee requests that your testimony be submitted by 10 a.m. on Friday, June 15.
