3 **SEC. 204. EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN NATIONAL EMER-**  
4 **GENCIES INVOKING INTERNATIONAL EMER-**  
5 **GENCY ECONOMIC POWERS ACT.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—In the case of a national emer-  
7 gency described in subsection (b), the provisions of this  
8 Act, as in effect on the day before the date of the enact-  
9 ment of the Assuring that Robust, Thorough, and In-  
10 formed Congressional Leadership is Exercised Over Na-

1 tional Emergencies Act, shall continue to apply on and  
2 after such date of enactment.

3 (b) NATIONAL EMERGENCY DESCRIBED.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—A national emergency de-  
5 scribed in this subsection is a national emergency  
6 pursuant to which the President proposes to exercise  
7 emergency powers or authorities made available  
8 under the International Emergency Economic Pow-  
9 ers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.), supplemented as  
10 necessary by a provision of law specified in para-  
11 graph (2).

12 (2) PROVISIONS OF LAW SPECIFIED.—The pro-  
13 visions of law specified in this paragraph are—

14 (A) the United Nations Participation Act  
15 of 1945 (22 U.S.C. 287 et seq.);

16 (B) section 212(f) of the Immigration and  
17 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(f)); or

18 (C) any provision of law that authorizes  
19 the implementation, imposition, or enforcement  
20 of economic sanctions with respect to a foreign  
21 country.

22 (c) EFFECT OF ADDITIONAL POWERS AND AUTHORI-  
23 TIES.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to a national emer-  
24 gency or the exercise of emergency powers and authorities  
25 pursuant to the national emergency if, in addition to the

1 exercise of emergency powers and authorities described in  
2 subsection (b), the President proposes to exercise pursu-  
3 ant to the national emergency—

4           (1) any other emergency powers and authorities  
5           under the International Emergency Economic Pow-  
6           ers Act; or

7           (2) any emergency powers and authorities  
8           under any other provision of law.
