3	This Act may be cited as the "Government Shutdown
4	Prevention Act of 2019".
5	SEC. 2. AUTOMATIC CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS.
6	(a) In General.—Chapter 13 of title 31, United
7	States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1310
8	the following new section:
9	"SEC. 1311. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS.
10	"(a)(1) If any appropriation measure for a fiscal year
11	is not enacted before the beginning of such fiscal year or
12	a joint resolution making continuing appropriations is not

1	in effect, there are appropriated such sums as may be nec-
2	essary to continue any program, project, or activity for
3	which funds were provided in the preceding fiscal year—
4	"(A) in the corresponding appropriation Act for
5	such preceding fiscal year; or
6	"(B) if the corresponding appropriation bill for
7	such preceding fiscal year did not become law, then
8	in a joint resolution making continuing appropria-
9	tions for such preceding fiscal year.
10	"(2)(A) Appropriations and funds made available,
11	and authority granted, for a program, project, or activity
12	for any fiscal year pursuant to this section shall be at a
13	rate of operations not in excess of the lower of—
14	"(i) 99 percent of the rate of operations pro-
15	vided for in the regular appropriation Act providing
16	for such program, project, or activity for the pre-
17	ceding fiscal year;
18	"(ii) in the absence of such an Act, 99 percent
19	of the rate of operations provided for such program,
20	project, or activity pursuant to a joint resolution
21	making continuing appropriations for such preceding
22	fiscal year; or
23	"(iii) 99 percent of the annualized rate of oper-
24	ations provided for in the most recently enacted
25	joint resolution making continuing appropriations

1 for part of that fiscal year or any funding levels es-

- 2 tablished under the provisions of this Act,
- 3 for the period of 90 days. After the first 90-day period
- 4 during which this subsection is in effect for that fiscal
- 5 year, the applicable rate of operations shall be reduced by
- 6 1 percentage point. For each subsequent 90-day period
- 7 during which this subsection is in effect for that fiscal
- 8 year, the applicable rate of operations shall be reduced by
- 9 1 percentage point. The 90-day period reductions shall ex-
- 10 tend beyond the last day of that fiscal year.
- 11 "(B) If this section is in effect at the end of a fiscal
- 12 year, funding levels shall continue as provided in this sec-
- 13 tion for the next fiscal year.
- 14 "(3) Appropriations and funds made available, and
- 15 authority granted, for any fiscal year pursuant to this sec-
- 16 tion for a program, project, or activity shall be available
- 17 for the period beginning with the first day of a lapse in
- 18 appropriations and ending with the date on which the ap-
- 19 plicable regular appropriation bill for such fiscal year be-
- 20 comes law (whether or not such law provides for such pro-
- 21 gram, project, or activity) or a continuing resolution mak-
- 22 ing appropriations becomes law, as the case may be.
- 23 "(b) An appropriation or funds made available, or au-
- 24 thority granted, for a program, project, or activity for any
- 25 fiscal year pursuant to this section shall be subject to the

1 terms and conditions imposed with respect to the appro-

- 2 priation made or funds made available for the preceding
- 3 fiscal year, or authority granted for such program, project,
- 4 or activity under current law.
- 5 "(c) Expenditures made for a program, project, or
- 6 activity for any fiscal year pursuant to this section shall
- 7 be charged to the applicable appropriation, fund, or au-
- 8 thorization whenever a regular appropriation bill or a joint
- 9 resolution making continuing appropriations until the end
- 10 of a fiscal year providing for such program, project, or
- 11 activity for such period becomes law.
- 12 "(d) This section shall not apply to a program,
- 13 project, or activity during a fiscal year if any other provi-
- 14 sion of law (other than an authorization of appropria-
- 15 tions)—
- 16 "(1) makes an appropriation, makes funds
- available, or grants authority for such program,
- project, or activity to continue for such period; or
- 19 "(2) specifically provides that no appropriation
- shall be made, no funds shall be made available, or
- 21 no authority shall be granted for such program,
- project, or activity to continue for such period.".
