25	additional activities supporting these efforts, and

how the Department of Homeland Security is apply ing this information to current and future COVID 19 pandemic work to the Committee on Homeland
 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate
 and the Committee on Homeland Security of the
 House of Representatives.

7 (2) ADDITIONAL BRIEFING.—Not later than 8 180 days after the date on which the Director of the 9 Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency 10 provides the briefing required under paragraph (1), 11 and every 180 days thereafter until the date that is 12 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act, the 13 Director of the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Se-14 curity Agency shall provide an updated version of 15 the briefing to the Committee on Homeland Security 16 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate and the 17 Committee on Homeland Security of the House of 18 Representatives.
