1 At the end of the bill, add the following:

2 **SEC. 3. PROCUREMENT FOR BORDER WALL CONSTRUCTION.**

4 (a) **TERMINATION OF PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION**  
5 **10142.—**

6 (1) **IN GENERAL.—**Notwithstanding any other  
7 provision of law, beginning on the date of the enact-  
8 ment of this Act—

9 (A) the Secretary of Homeland Security or  
10 any other Federal official may not implement

1 the provisions of Presidential Proclamation  
2 10142; and

3 (B) all regulations, policies, and oper-  
4 ational guidance contained in such proclamation  
5 that have been implemented shall be imme-  
6 diately terminated.

7 (2) REVERSION TO PRIOR TERMS.—Notwith-  
8 standing any other provision of law, upon the termi-  
9 nation of all regulations, policies, and operational  
10 modifications that have been issued to implement  
11 Presidential Proclamation 10142, all contracts for  
12 the construction or improvement of any physical bar-  
13 rier along the United States border shall be carried  
14 out in accordance with the terms set in effect before  
15 January 20, 2021.

16 (b) PROHIBITION OF CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS.—  
17 The Secretary of Homeland Security may not carry out  
18 any successor Executive Order, Presidential Proclamation,  
19 regulation, policy guidance, or operational guidance that  
20 seeks to cancel, invalidate, breach, terminate, or impose  
21 additional environmental, agricultural, or other reviews re-  
22 quired by statute or regulation upon contracts that the  
23 Federal Government has already awarded for the con-  
24 struction or improvement of any physical barrier along the  
25 United States border.
