Viz:

1 On page 2, line 16, insert “freely or at negligible
2 cost” before “to”.

3 On page 7, strike lines 5 through 10 and insert the
4 following:

5 “(d) FEES.—

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Director may provide
7 any service relating to the availability of the .gov
8 internet domain program, including .gov domain
9 name registration services described in subsection
10 (a) and supporting services described in subsection

1 (c), to entities described in subsection (a)(1) with or
2 without reimbursement.

3 “(2) LIMITATION.—The total fees collected for
4 new .gov domain registrants or annual renewals of
5 .gov domains shall not exceed the direct operational
6 expenses of maintaining the .gov internet domain.

7 On page 14, line 12, strike “and”.

8 On page 14, line 15, strike the period and insert “;
9 and”.

10 On page 14, between lines 15 and 16, insert the fol-
11 lowing:

12 (5) the development, assessment, and deter-
13 mination of the amount of any fees imposed on new
14 .gov domain registrants or annual renewals of .gov
15 domains in accordance with section 2215(d) of the
16 Homeland Security Act of 2002, as added by section
17 4(b) of this Act.

18 On page 15, after line 14, add the following:

19 (e) During the 5-year period following the date of en-
20 actment of this Act, any fee charged for new .gov domain
21 registrants or annual renewals of .gov domains shall be
22 not more than the amount of the fee charged for such
23 registration or renewal as of October 1, 2019.
