**A BILL**

To amend chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, to require Federal agencies to submit to the Comptroller General of the United States a report on rules that are revoked, suspended, replaced, amended, or otherwise made ineffective.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “GAO Database Mod-  
5 ernization Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. RULES NO LONGER IN EFFECT.**

2 Section 801(a)(1) of title 5, United States Code, is  
3 amended by adding at the end the following:

4 “(D) For any rule submitted under subpara-  
5 graph (A), if the Federal agency promulgating the  
6 rule, in whole or in part, revokes, suspends, replaces,  
7 amends, or otherwise makes the rule ineffective, or  
8 the rule is made ineffective for any other reason, the  
9 Federal agency shall submit to the Comptroller Gen-  
10 eral a report containing—

11 “(i) the title of the rule;

12 “(ii) the Federal Register citation for the  
13 rule, if any;

14 “(iii) the date on which rule was submitted  
15 to the Comptroller General; and

16 “(iv) a description of the provisions of the  
17 rule that are being revoked, suspended, re-  
18 placed, amended, or otherwise made ineffec-  
19 tive.”.
