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## A BILL

To provide for the implementation of certain trafficking in contracting provisions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End Human Traf-  
5 ficking in Government Contracts Act of 2022”.

6 **SEC. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAFFICKING IN CON-**  
7 **TRACTING PROVISIONS.**

8 (a) REQUIREMENT TO REFER VIOLATIONS TO AGEN-  
9 CY SUSPENSION AND DEBARMENT OFFICIAL.—Section  
10 1704(c)(1) of the National Defense Authorization Act for

1 Fiscal Year 2013 (Public Law 112–239; 22 U.S.C.  
2 7104b(c)(1)) is amended—

3 (1) by inserting “refer the matter to the agency  
4 suspension and debarment official and” before “con-  
5 sider taking one of the following actions”; and

6 (2) by striking subparagraph (G).

7 (b) REPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAFFICKING  
8 IN CONTRACTING PROVISIONS.—Not later than 90 days  
9 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director  
10 of the Office of Management and Budget shall submit to  
11 Congress a report on implementation of title XVII of the  
12 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2013  
13 (Public Law 112–239; 126 Stat. 2092).

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
