A BILL

To modify the fire management assistance cost share, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fire Suppression Im-
5 provement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FIRE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE COST SHARE AND**
7 **ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 420 of the Robert T.
9 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
10 (42 U.S.C. 5187) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
2 section (g); and

3 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(e) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of assist-
6 ance under this section shall be not less than 75 percent
7 of the eligible cost of such assistance.

8 “(f) ELIGIBLE EXPENSE.—A State or local govern-
9 ment may use assistance provided under this section for
10 the predeployment of assets and resources.”.

11 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
12 section (a) shall only apply to amounts appropriated on
13 or after the date of enactment of this Act.

14 **SEC. 3. RULEMAKING.**

15 Not later than 3 years after the date of enactment
16 of this Act, the President, acting through the Adminis-
17 trator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency,
18 shall conduct and complete a rulemaking to provide cri-
19 teria for the circumstances under which the Administrator
20 may recommend the President increase the Federal cost
21 share for section 420 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster
22 Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5187).

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
