5 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
 6 gress that non-intrusive inspection systems should be used
 7 to detect and interdict illicit and dangerous goods and un-
 8 claimed money that flow out of the United States to sup-
 9 ply and fund transnational drug cartels.

10 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 270 days after the date
 11 of the enactment of this Act, the Commissioner of U.S.

1 Customs and Border Protection shall submit to the Com-
2 mittee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs
3 of the Senate and the Committee on Homeland Security
4 of the House of Representatives a report on the feasibility
5 of using non-intrusive inspection systems to scan 10 per-
6 cent of all vehicles exiting the United States through land
7 ports of entry by September 30, 2024.
