3 (c) GAO REVIEW AND REPORT.—

4 (1) REVIEW.—

5 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller Gen-  
6 eral of the United States shall conduct a review  
7 of the use by U.S. Customs and Border Protec-  
8 tion of non-intrusive inspection systems for bor-  
9 der security.

1 (B) ELEMENTS.—The review required by  
2 subparagraph (A) shall include the following:

3 (i) An identification of—

4 (I) the number and types of non-  
5 intrusive inspection systems deployed  
6 by U.S. Customs and Border Protec-  
7 tion; and

8 (II) the locations to which such  
9 systems have been deployed.

10 (ii) An examination of the manner in  
11 which U.S. Customs and Border Protec-  
12 tion—

13 (I) assesses the effectiveness of  
14 such systems; and

15 (II) uses such systems in con-  
16 junction with other border security re-  
17 sources and assets, such as border  
18 barriers and technology, to detect and  
19 interdict drug smuggling and traf-  
20 ficking at the southwest border of the  
21 United States.

22 (2) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the  
23 date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller  
24 General shall submit to the Committee on Homeland  
25 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate

1       and the Committee on Homeland Security of the  
2       House of Representatives a report on the findings of  
3       the review conducted under paragraph (1).
